The International Software Testing Qualifications Board (ISTQB®) is a non-profit association formed with the following objectives:



- To create and develop certificates recognized throughout the world, issued to participants who want to obtain the certificates of "ISTQB Certified Tester" after passing examinations on software testing
- To support this unique, universally accepted, certification system, managed by software and system test professionals
- To provide syllabuses whose content changes with time to reflect technical and professional developments

The Egyptian Software Testing Board (ESTB) was founded on December 17, 2008 by a group of software engineering and testing practitioners, consultants, academics and trainers. The ESTB was awarded admission as Member Board of ISTQB on March 26, 2009.



The ESTB has appointed the Software Engineering Competence Center (SECC) as the sole ESTB Examination Institute/ Certification Body for the ISTQB certificates in Egypt.

Currently, two levels of ISTQB certifications exist:

- The ISTQB Certified Tester Foundation Level (CTFL)
- The ISTQB Certified Tester Advanced Level (CTAL)

The CTFL is aimed at anyone involved in software testing. This includes roles such as testers, test analysts, test engineers, test consultants, test managers, and software developers. It is also appropriate for anyone who wants a basic understanding of software testing, such as project managers, quality managers, software development managers, business analysts, and IT directors.

The CTAL is aimed at people with experience in software testing. This includes roles as above. It is also appropriate for anyone who wants a deeper understanding of software testing. To apply for CTAL examination, candidates must already hold the CTFL. The CTAL certification types are:

- Advanced Level Test Manager
- Advanced Level Test Analyst
- Advanced Level Technical Test Analyst
